**Re: On-site COVID-19 Vaccination Program**

Dear Local 281 Member:

Sprinkler Fitters Local Union Local 281, U.A. is partnering with the University of Chicago/Ingalls Hospital System to offer on-site COVID-19 vaccines for Local 281 Members and their families. This vaccination program is scheduled for Thursday, May 6, 2021, in the Local 281 Training Center/Union Hall. Depending on what vaccine will be administered, this program may include dependent children 16 years of age, up to 26, if they are still covered by the Local 281 Health Plan.

This notice will be posted on the website and be sent via text message and email. There will be a link to a survey, Local 281 will need to know how many members are interested in this program, to allow Ingalls Hospital to place a vaccine order with the Illinois Department of Public Health. There is currently a shortage of vaccines and to avoid ordering too few or too many vaccines, we need an accurate count of how many members and family will attend. **We need the survey results by Tuesday, April 20, 2021.**
